Through this public call, professionals are invited to submit their applications to participate in the activities that will take place during the celebration of SISON Enclave Musical 2024, providing them with the opportunity to take the first steps in a project of dialogue, creation of new forms of dissemination, and promotion of music in Galicia.

PARTICIPANTS

This call is directed towards professionals in the sector, responsible for programming in both public and private settings, responsible for programming theater concerts, responsible for programming fairs and festivals, among others.

FOR PROFESSIONALS AND PROGRAMMERS

- 1. Accept the terms of the call, as well as the processing of data by the event organizers.

- 3. They must provide documentary evidence that they hold a position as a programmer, either in the public or private sector.
- 4. By registering, the participant authorizes the organization to take and publish photographs of the attendees at the events in which they participate, for the purpose of promoting and disseminating the event.

PARTICIPATION OF PROFESSIONALS IN BUSINESS ROUNDS

For participation in the sessions of the business conference, which will take place on Friday, October 18, from 10:00 to 11:30 a.m., and Saturday, October 19, from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m., with an approximate duration of 10 minutes, programmers who wish to actively participate can indicate their interest in the corresponding section of the registration form, with the aim of maintaining a proactive dialogue on the new challenges, concerns, and projects of the music ecosystem. There will be no registration fee for programmers for this activity.*

In case of wanting to participate actively, programmers must specify this in the registration form.

ABOUT ARTISTIC SHOWCASES

SISON will schedule promotional presentations lasting 30 minutes and lectures. In addition, business sessions will be held, where bidders and applicants can present their doubts and achieve convergence of interests.

The planned presentations will be made by artists selected by the organization and will be aimed at professional programmers and SISON participants in general.

RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

Participants in the call commit to the event organization to:

- Comply with copyright protection rules with all products, artistic works, performances, or artistic executions that are part of the proposals submitted.
- Certify documentarily that programmers, whether public or private, at the time of the SISON execution, comply with labor and administrative regulations, providing any documentation regarding the activity requested by the SISON organization within the deadline and form determined by it.
- Accept the terms and regulations of the call, as well as any clarification or modification thereof.
- Fulfill the conditions stated in this document, understanding that the participant must practice them throughout the term of the call. If at any time the interested party fails to comply with any of these conditions, they may be excluded from the call.
- Accept the result of the call and actively participate.
- Attend and participate in SISON 2024, which will take place between October 16 and 19 in Santiago de Compostela.
- Interested professional programmers wishing to participate in established events and activities should note that the organization offers to cover the accommodation and meals expenses of various professional participants during October 16 and 17, whose resolution will be communicated by email after analyzing all applications.

ORGANIZATION'S DUTIES

- Provide properly equipped spaces for the different activities organized for the participation of programmers.
- Develop a coordinated work plan that allows for the proper execution of presentations, speed meetings, and showcases.
- Call and invite programmers, producers, and other professionals interested in the cultural offering.
